The archdiocese has provided a "Lesson Launch" for our church school teachers for this year's curriculum, Luke-Acts. The Lesson Launch consists of three workshop activities for church school teachers. They are flexible and adaptable. They include an introductory video, workshop activity for directors and teachers, and a stand-alone Luke-Acts lesson plan that introduces the teachers to some key themes from this year's Luke-Acts curriculum.
